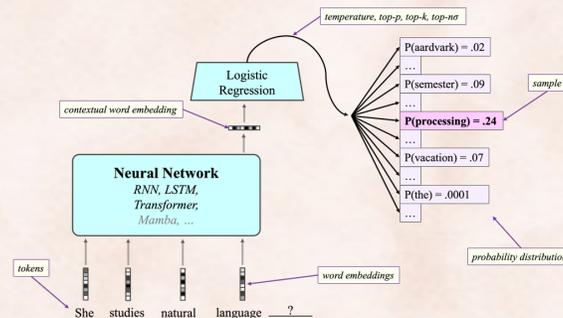

Project Proposal: Structure

- Typically, up to 2 pages (but more is fine if needed), describing in concrete terms:
 - The **problem** (task) you plan to solve (build a prototype solution).
 - What is the input, what is the output.
 - Why is the problem important.
 - The **data** you plan to use for evaluation (testing) or development (training), if needed:
 - How to create it, or where to get it from.
 - The **approach** you plan to implement:
 - Provide some concrete ideas, just saying “*an LLM-based approach*” is too vague.

Project Proposal: Novelty

- What is the **novel contribution** of this project:
 - Is the **task** novel, i.e., nobody has done it before?
 - Provide evidence you have substantial knowledge of the task / domain.
 - Is the **approach** novel?
 - Provide some argument why your approach may be better than existing approaches.
 - What are the other approaches?
 - Is it the **task + approach** combination novel?
 - Provide justification for the benefits of this novel combination.
 - Is there **another aspect** that is novel?
