## 7.02 Nonperiodical (ex. Books)

Author, A. A. (1994). *Title of work*. Location: Publisher.

Editor, A. A. (Ed.). (year). *Title of work*. Location: Publisher.

Author, A. A. (1994). *Title of work*. (2<sup>nd</sup> ed.). Location: Publisher.

## Part of a nonperiodical (ex. Book chapter)

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (1994). Title of chapter. In A. Editor, B. Editor, & C. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (pp. xxx-xxx). Location: Publisher.

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (1994). Title of chapter. In A. Editor, B. Editor, & C. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (2<sup>nd</sup> ed., pp. xxx-xxx). Location: Publisher.

## Online document

Author, A. A. (year). *Title of work*. Retrieved from <http://www.xxxxx>.

## 7.03 Technical Reports (cite like books)

Author, A. A. (year). *Title of work* (Report No. xxx). Location: Publisher.

## 7.04 Presentation or Poster Session

Presenter, A. A. (year, Month). *Title of paper or poster*. Paper or poster session presented at the meeting of Organization Name, Location.

## 7.06 Review of a book

Review, A. A. (Year, Month day). Title of review [Review of the book *Title of book*, by A. A. Author]. *Title of complete work*, xx, xxx-xxx. doi: xx.xxxxxxxxxx
